More than **7,000** unduplicated clients served. Data integrity improvements to more accurately count clients served, eliminated inflated counts from previous years.

VOLUNTEER SERVICES
10,086 volunteer hours.



BAKHITA EMPOWERMENT PROGRAM
Served **238** human trafficking survivors and refugees. **\$164,171** in rental assistance provided.



INTERFAITH HEALTH AND WELLNESS

317 community members received health education and outreach. **8** new nurses attended the “Foundations of Faith Community Nursing” course that transitioned to online instruction during COVID-19.



IMMIGRATION LEGAL SERVICES

assisted **41** clients in successfully achieving their citizenship status.



COUNSELING
319 unduplicated clients. **1,512** telehealth hours during COVID-19. Provided **2,793** therapy sessions.

RESPECT LIFE
17 students and **46** adults from our diocese attended Catholic Days at the Capitol.



SAMARITAN CENTER
55 homeless clients served, **93%** of which are now self-sufficient.



BIRTHLINE/LIFELINE

Pregnancy Care Centers served **1,690** pregnant women, with **871** as new clients.



WOMEN'S PREGNANCY SOLUTIONS

2 mobile pregnancy units were donated by God's Resources, launching this as our newest program.



RESPIRE SERVICES

119 in-person visits pre-COVID-19, **107** phone calls to check status of caregivers during COVID-19, served **18** caregivers.



PRISON MINISTRY
14,000 volunteer hours
155 ministers in **20** facilities.

ELDER AFFAIRS

Served **250** seniors with program services, protecting vulnerable elderly from exploitation and abuse.



HUNGER, HOMELESS AND OUTREACH

Provided **\$579,745** in rent/utilities/emergency housing to **465** households consisting of **1,395** individuals.





PARISH SOCIAL MINISTRIES
